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1 (Beginning of recorded material.)

2 DET. WIREMAN: The time now is 1631, 1631 hours.

3 This is Detective Wireman with Detective Merlot here
4 interviewing Roy Kidd at Post 9. Roy is represented by
5 Tim Parker in this interview. So --

6 DET. MERLOT: Previously your rights were read to
7 you.

8 MR. KIDD: Yeah.

9 DET. MERLOT: You still understand that, right?

10 MR. PARKER: We acknowledge he's been Mirandized.

11 DET. MERLOT: Okay.

12 DET. WIREMAN: So, let's go back over a few things
13 starting with the time that you woke up Mr. McKinney.
14 You found Amber on the couch, and she had blood on her,
15 and you said that you believed that she had hemorrhaged
16 or --

17 MR. KIDD: Yeah. That's how we see it when we
18 have CAT scans and other things that's just my
19 experience -- work experience.

20 DET. WIREMAN: So, walk me again just one more
21 time what you do exactly after that.

22 MR. KIDD: When I found her?

23 DET. WIREMAN: Uh-huh.

24 MR. KIDD: I touched her shoulders, just her
25 sleeves, and shook her twice and screamed her name, saw

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1 the blood was all dried, and I went to Mike's room,
2 which was adjacent to the living room, and beat on the
3 door for him to come help.

4 DET. MERLOT: What did he say as soon as he come
5 to the door?

6 MR. KIDD: He didn't really say much of anything.
7 I mean --

8 DET. MERLOT: What --

9 MR. KIDD: -- just thought --

10 DET. MERLOT: -- did you exactly tell him then?

11 MR. KIDD: I just said can you call 911 or call --
12 I said something -- I said looks like she's had a
13 stroke or a bleed.

14 DET. MERLOT: Okay.

15 MR. KIDD: And he stepped back in his bedroom, and
16 I don't know if it was one or two calls before the
17 other calls sounded like that's when I heard the
18 address.

19 DET. MERLOT: Did he come out and look at her?
20 Did he come out and see her?

21 MR. KIDD: He --

22 DET. MERLOT: Didn't you find that kind of weird I
23 mean --

24 MR. KIDD: He stepped out of the bedroom door and
25 he -- and went straight back in his room.

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1 DET. MERLOT: But was it weird --

2 MR. KIDD: And the door was kind of half, you
3 know, and then he kind of just let the door go back
4 because it wasn't in the dining room wide enough to --

5 DET. WIREMAN: Did you tell him that she was dead
6 or did you say --

7 MR. KIDD: I said something's happened to her. I
8 said looks like a stroke or a bleed because that's what
9 it kind of looked like kind of --

10 DET. WIREMAN: But you -- but you thought she was
11 dead, though?

12 MR. KIDD: The way the blood was dried, it looked
13 -- I mean just from what I --

14 DET. MERLOT: You ever seen dried blood on
15 somebody like a stroke victim still alive?

16 MR. KIDD: Not dried, no.

17 DET. MERLOT: You ever seen dried blood on anybody
18 that's still alive? I mean is it possible?

19 MR. KIDD: I've seen dried blood on different
20 MVA's or gunshots --

21 DET. MERLOT: So, it's possible, right?

22 MR. KIDD: Yeah.

23 DET. MERLOT: With 30 years of experience you've
24 seen dried blood and just thought she's dead, I'm not
25 fully -- like I said you didn't check a pulse? You're

3 DET. MERLOT: I just think it's awkward that you
4 didn't try anything. You just shook her twice and said
5 she's dead.

6 MR. KIDD: Her eyes were fixed and the blood was
7 dried, and I just wanted somebody to help me. I just
8 panicked and beat on his door.

9 DET. MERLOT: Thirty years of medical you didn't
10 try anything. You didn't call 911. You rely on
11 somebody else.

12 MR. KIDD: I -- yeah, I just got him to call for
13 me. I was just in a --

14 DET. MERLOT: And then when he didn't call, you
15 still didn't call 911 asking for help.

16 MR. KIDD: I don't even know honestly if my phone
17 was on me or not.

18 DET. MERLOT: But you didn't try to find --

19 MR. KIDD: I don't know -- I don't know how --

20 DET. MERLOT: -- but I mean but even if you --

21 MR. KIDD: -- I don't know what happens.

22 DET. MERLOT: -- but you didn't look for a phone.
23 You didn't try to call 911.

24 MR. KIDD: I don't know if I had one (INAUDIBLE).

25 DET. MERLOT: But you didn't try to call 911,

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1 right?

2 MR. KIDD: No. I don't know if I even had a phone
3 on me.

4 DET. MERLOT: So, this woman is possibly deceased,
5 and you're only concern was to tell Mike who stuck his
6 head out and really didn't pay that much attention?
7 And you're a medical field --

8 MR. KIDD: But he's the doctor.

9 DET. MERLOT: -- you're experienced. You didn't
10 try to help her?

11 MR. KIDD: Doctor, and I thought I don't know he's
12 a doctor. I thought he --

13 DET. MERLOT: He's a doctor of what?

14 MR. KIDD: He's a dentist, but he's been trained
15 in more --

16 DET. MERLOT: But you're trained too 30 years to
17 way more than --

18 MR. KIDD: But I'm not, you know, a doctor.

19 DET. MERLOT: But you didn't try to help her,
20 though?

21 MR. KIDD: No. I mean I -- like I said, I tried
22 to -- I -- after she didn't respond, and she --

23 DET. MERLOT: You knew she was already dead?

24 MR. KIDD: That's what it appeared to be.

25 DET. MERLOT: Because there's some dried blood on

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1 her? They check for a pulse?

2 MR. KIDD: Her eyes were fixed. That's all. I
3 just --

4 DET. MERLOT: You ever seen a stroke victim lay on
5 the floor for three or four days alive? You know that
6 can happen? Somebody can have a stroke and lay in the
7 floor and I mean it could happen.

8 MR. KIDD: Yeah. We've had them come into the ER,
9 yeah.

10 DET. MERLOT: But this one here you just wrote her
11 off?

12 MR. KIDD: I didn't write her off. I was just in
13 a panic. I just --

14 DET. MERLOT: You sure you didn't know she was
15 dead before you ever got to her?

16 MR. KIDD: No.

17 DET. MERLOT: How come?

18 MR. KIDD: Well, she -- like I said, when I come
19 down the hallway, her back was sitting or I could see
20 the back of her head until I walked around, and I was
21 like thinking she was awake already. And then I saw
22 her, and then I just grabbed her shoulders, and then --

23 DET. MERLOT: Where was Mike at?

24 MR. KIDD: In his room.

25 DET. MERLOT: And so when you banged on that door,

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1 does he come out of his room all the way or just stick
2 his head out or what do you remember?

3 MR. KIDD: He maybe took one step out.

4 DET. MERLOT: Then he could see her?

5 MR. KIDD: He seen her.

6 DET. MERLOT: And he didn't try to help her
7 either, did he?

8 MR. KIDD: No. He --

9 DET. MERLOT: Did you find that kind of weird?

10 MR. KIDD: I was just in a -- I was in shock. I
11 was in shock.

12 DET. MERLOT: But he's a doctor, right?

13 MR. KIDD: Well, yes.

14 DET. MERLOT: Medical doctor. Well, he's a
15 dentist, but he's a doctor with experience.

16 MR. KIDD: And he stepped back in.

17 DET. MERLOT: What's your normal -- what would a
18 normal person probably done?

19 MR. KIDD: Pulse, CPR.

20 DET. MERLOT: And I would have thought when you
21 seen a person covered -- I mean I don't know how much
22 blood she had, I wasn't there, but --

23 MR. KIDD: She was covered.

24 DET. MERLOT: -- somebody with blood --

25 MR. KIDD: That's why I was just --

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1 DET. MERLOT: -- didn't try to put her in the
2 floor, didn't try to do anything.

3 MR. KIDD: I didn't. I was afraid to move her.

4 DET. MERLOT: What's one of the first steps? I
5 mean is 911 not one of the first steps, though? And
6 you didn't even try.

7 MR. KIDD: I don't even think I -- I don't know
8 where my phone was at. I mean --

9 DET. MERLOT: But you didn't even go look. I mean
10 you just -- you didn't --

11 MR. KIDD: I don't know --

12 DET. MERLOT: -- you weren't concerned about
13 calling 911 for some reason.

14 MR. KIDD: Yes. I banged on the door for him to
15 call really because I knew (INAUDIBLE).

16 DET. MERLOT: But he's trying to make a phone call
17 to somebody else other than 911, you still didn't say -
18 -

19 MR. KIDD: I didn't look --

20 DET. MERLOT: -- in my medical experience, I need
21 to find a phone and call 911?

22 MR. KIDD: I don't know if they had landlines. I
23 was just in shock. I just --

24 DET. MERLOT: When he was on 911, do you remember
25 talking to him -- to Mike?

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1 MR. KIDD: I didn't talk to him, no.

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2 DET. WIREMAN: You did.

3 MR. KIDD: I --

4 DET. MERLOT: He didn't ask you anything?

5 MR. KIDD: Did I ask him anything?

6 DET. MERLOT: He didn't ask you anything?

7 MR. KIDD: I asked him where MK was after he hung
8 up.

9 DET. MERLOT: While he's on the 911 call.

10 MR. KIDD: No. While he's on the phone or --

11 DET. MERLOT: He didn't ask you who she was, what
12 her name was, how old she was?

13 MR. KIDD: He knew her. They worked -- she works
14 for them.

15 DET. MERLOT: Do you know what? Mike knew she was
16 murdered.

17 MR. KIDD: He knew she was?

18 DET. MERLOT: He told Dispatch I've got a murdered
19 girl in my house, and he's asking you questions, and
20 nobody seems to be concerned that there's somebody
21 murdered in the house and somebody in that house
22 murdered her. Why is nobody concerned?

23 MR. KIDD: I thought it was a natural cause. I
24 had no idea she was murdered.

25 DET. MERLOT: Mike -- I mean you heard the phone

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1 call, right, Mike called 911?

2 MR. KIDD: I heard the address given, yeah.

3 DET. MERLOT: So, you didn't hear him tell the

4 Dispatcher she was murdered?

5 MR. KIDD: Uh-uh.

6 DET. MERLOT: You don't -- Mike never comes out

7 and says guys, I think she's been murdered?

8 MR. KIDD: Not that I'm aware of. I mean it was -

9 -

10 DET. MERLOT: Not that you're aware of or he

11 didn't?

12 MR. KIDD: I don't remember him saying that. But

13 like I said, I was in the dining room.

14 DET. MERLOT: He asked you questions, though.

15 You're responding. On the 911 tape, we can hear you in

16 the background hollering her name's Amber, what her age

17 is.

18 DET. WIREMAN: He asked you what her name is and -

19 -

20 DET. MERLOT: You said late 30's.

21 DET. WIREMAN: -- what her age is.

22 MR. KIDD: I said she's late 30's.

23 DET. WIREMAN: So you remember now?

24 DET. MERLOT: So, Mike's talking to you on 9 --

25 while he's talking to Dispatch.

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1 MR. KIDD: I don't recall that.

2 DET. WIREMAN: Well, you just told us you told her
3 -- told him the age.

4 MR. KIDD: I can remember that now, but like I
5 said she works for them so he knew her name, but I was
6 in such a state of shock I mean I didn't -- that's all
7 I know.

8 DET. MERLOT: You not find it odd that Mike --
9 nobody came to try and help her?

10 MR. KIDD: Yeah.

11 DET. MERLOT: I mean if you had a woman in your
12 house and you're the homeowner, what would you have
13 done?

14 MR. KIDD: Yeah I --

15 DET. MERLOT: What would you have done?

16 MR. KIDD: -- I would have pulled her to the floor
17 and tried CPR or something.

18 DET. MERLOT: But this instance it wasn't your
19 house, and you walked right up to her and still didn't
20 help her.

21 MR. KIDD: I tried to bring her to, and then --

22 DET. MERLOT: By shaking her? You're going to
23 save her life by shaking her?

24 MR. KIDD: No. I thought she -- I didn't know she
25 was dead. I mean I --

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1 DET. MERLOT: Ah --

2 MR. KIDD: -- I knew something had happened.

3 Looked like a bleed.

4 DET. MERLOT: So you didn't know she was dead?

5 MR. KIDD: It looked like a brain bleed or an
6 aneurysm, and then I seen all the dried blood in her
7 eyes, and I assumed she was by the way that looked.

8 DET. WIREMAN: How much blood did she have on her?

9 MR. KIDD: It looked like it had saturated the
10 couch.

11 DET. WIREMAN: So, she -- she did -- so, she's
12 bled out somehow?

13 MR. KIDD: Yeah. That's why I thought it was a
14 bleed.

15 DET. WIREMAN: And you --

16 MR. KIDD: And there was -- I mean that's why I
17 thought it was like aneurysm.

18 DET. WIREMAN: Have you seen a bleed produce that
19 much blood?

20 MR. KIDD: The dissection of an aorta or
21 something, yes.

22 DET. WIREMAN: That much blood? I mean --

23 MR. KIDD: Yeah. Way down because --

24 DET. WIREMAN: -- the cushions were --

25 MR. KIDD: -- your aorta. I mean that's what I've

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1 seen. An aortic dissection, I mean everything bleeds
2 out.

3 DET. WIREMAN: So, let's go back. You said that
4 you were -- you were in MK's bedroom/bathroom. Where
5 did you fall at?

6 MR. KIDD: Well, numerous places in the room and
7 the bathroom.

8 DET. WIREMAN: Where did you cut yourself or --

9 MR. KIDD: Under my chin.

10 DET. WIREMAN: -- hurt yourself?

11 MR. KIDD: There are bruises from furniture. I
12 know there --

13 DET. WIREMAN: What room was that in, is what I
14 mean?

15 MR. KIDD: MK's room and the bathroom. They're
16 all -- it's all -- honestly, it's one room.

17 DET. WIREMAN: So there should have been blood in
18 there?

19 MR. KIDD: That or on the bed.

20 DET. WIREMAN: I mean you bled enough to cover --

21 MR. KIDD: Never --

22 DET. WIREMAN: -- your shirt you said, so, there
23 should be blood on the floor, sheets, bathroom,
24 somewhere?

25 MR. KIDD: Yeah. I mean I would think.

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1 DET. WIREMAN: Well, when I looked at it, there
2 was no blood anywhere in that bedroom, that bathroom.
3 Why would that be?

4 MR. KIDD: I don't know.

5 DET. WIREMAN: Did somebody clean it up?

6 MR. KIDD: I wasn't able to do anything. I was --
7 couldn't even stand up. I didn't have any lights on.
8 I mean I was, like I said, I would crawl, and then I
9 would fall back into something.

10 DET. MERLOT: So you didn't clean up anything at
11 all in that house? Not your blood, urine --

12 MR. KIDD: No.

13 DET. MERLOT: -- feces, nothing like that, nothing
14 else?

15 MR. KIDD: It was on me. I couldn't -- that's why
16 I called Ladonna to bring me some clothes or come get
17 me, but she didn't answer.

18 DET. MERLOT: At what point did you find your cell
19 phone?

20 MR. KIDD: I think I called her like at -- no, but
21 that was like at 6:30 or something.

22 DET. WIREMAN: Ladonna?

23 MR. KIDD: But nobody answered. I completely
24 messed and I just wanted somebody to come get me or
25 help me get clothes or get home or something because I

1 couldn't make it from the bed to the bathroom in time.

2 That kind of stuff makes me sick to my stomach.

3 DET. MERLOT: After you found Amber, you didn't

4 have a cell phone you said, or you couldn't find it.

5 Do you remember when you found it?

6 MR. KIDD: No. I can remember sometime through

7 the night like feeling on the bed or the nightstand

8 when I would get up to go to the bathroom or fall. I

9 don't remember.

10 MR. PARKER: Can you give us a few minutes?

11 DET. MERLOT: Sure.

12 MR. PARKER: Please?

13 DET. WIREMAN: Sure. Time now is 164 --

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
