Pending before the Court is Defendant M.K. McKinney’s Renewed Motion to Reduce Bond. Having taken the matter under submission, reviewed the record, reviewed the parties’ papers and briefs and considering the parties arguments made at the hearings, the Court HEREBY MODIFIES bond in this case as follows.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that bail is modified and set at \$5,000,000 which may be secured by the combination of a \$500,000 property bond (which requires posting of real property with a value of \$1,005,000) and \$4,500,000 partially secured with 10% cash (\$450,000).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all the following nonfinancial conditions apply to the Defendant’s release:


1. Defendant shall **appear at all court hearings** including the next hearing scheduled on February 26, 2026 at the hour of 10:00 a.m.
2. Defendant shall **not have any violations of law** and shall report any arrest immediately.
3. Defendant shall **not possess any type of weapon**, including but not limited to any type of knife or firearm.
4. Defendant shall **not consume or possess any alcoholic beverages or drug not prescribed** to him/her by a treating physician who is licensed in the Commonwealth of Kentucky and shall not be upon the premises of any place that sells or serves alcoholic beverages as its primary business.

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5. Defendant shall **not drive or operate any motor vehicle** unless he/she has a valid Kentucky operator's license and the vehicle is insured as required by Kentucky law.
6. Defendant shall be **subject to the random testing of his/her blood, breath, hair or urine** for the presence of alcohol or drugs. Such testing shall be at defendant's expense and results shall be submitted to the Court and Attorney for the Commonwealth within 72 hours if requested by the Court, Attorney for the Commonwealth, or any peace officer.
7. Defendant shall not use any prescribed scheduled drug including **buprenorphine or methadone** unless the Court finds the use acceptable based upon an individualized assessment.
8. Defendant shall have **only one Kentucky family physician and one Kentucky pharmacy.**
9. Defendant shall have no contact with any family member of the victim's family directly or indirectly nor have communication with the victim's family in writing, through social media or third parties and shall remain at all times at least 500 feet from any family member of the victim.
10. Defendant shall not leave the Commonwealth of Kentucky without the prior written consent of this Court.
11. Defendant shall obey all Orders of the Court and all other lawful order(s) of any other court of apparent jurisdiction.
12. The Defendant shall surrender his U.S. Passport.
13. Defendant shall be under home incarceration with GPS monitoring. Defendant shall bare all costs/fees related to his home incarceration.
14. Defendant shall not be permitted to live with Michael McKinney II or Josh Mullins, the Co-Defendants in this case.
